Dear DePaul Catholic High School Community:

The Class of 2021 has completed their last day of class and we are into Senior Final Exams. We have made it this far because of the commitment of our school community to abiding by the health and safety regulations that have been imposed upon us and by looking out for one another. It has not been easy but, together, we look forward to a successful conclusion of the school year.

The Senior Prom will be on June 1, 2021 with Graduation practices later that week and Graduation to be held on Monday, June 7, 2021 at 6:00 PM. Graduation will be held outside and seniors will receive two tickets for reserved seats (or for admission into the gym should it rain, as there is no rain date). There will be no Baccalaureate Mass. The graduation ceremony will start with a prayer service and the presentation of senior awards and scholarships. At the current time, outdoor gatherings are limited to 500 people (socially distanced) so others will be admitted to the outdoor ceremony until capacity is reached and on a first come basis.

The school and offices are closed on May 28, 2021 for our Bishop's Holiday. With the upcoming Memorial Day weekend and prom celebration, we urge you to please keep your guard up and comply with all safety regulations. Graduation is less than a week after prom and it would be unfortunate if not all students and guests would be eligible to attend. Irrespective of any changes to safety protocols announced by the federal or state government, we will continue with the procedures that are in place until the end of this school year and we will announce our plans for the opening of school in September during the summer months.

The Passaic County Golf Championship was a family affair - the Scelba family, that is

DePaul sophomore Damian Scelba won Monday's individual title at Preakness Valley Golf Course in Wayne. His brother, Dominic, a senior, was third, and they led the Spartans to the team championship with their father, Anthony, as coach. "It's pretty special. I'm overwhelmed with joy just to think about it," said Anthony Scelba, a 1994 DePaul graduate. "Twenty years from now, we can laugh about this. I'm getting choked up just talking about it." Damian Scelba shot 2-over-par 72 on the East Course to finish one stroke ahead of Wayne Valley senior Jedd Alcalde. Dominic Scelba was third with 74. Damian Scelba played his back nine at 3-under, featuring an eagle, to come back and win. DePaul carded a four-player total of 323 to finish 52 strokes ahead of defending champion Wavne Valley. Senior Luke Bianchi added 86 and senior Dylan Cabri 91 to help the senior-heavy Spartans win the county title for the first time in more than a decade.

"I'm glad that we got to play, I'm glad that my seniors got to leave as champs, and I'm just so happy for the team," Anthony Scelba said.
