Nobody's perfect. It's the road to perfection that is important. Do the best you can...every day!



Athletic Training News

This Spring Nancy Keil, our Athletic Trainer, began the process of streaming most athletic medical forms to an online system. This Summer and Fall, this became a reality. With the use of the RSchool Activity Registration system, 261 student-athletes registered to participate in a Fall Sport. **That's 52% of our student body!**

While the State still requires some forms to be filled out hard copy, coaches now have access to their team's emergency information via an app on their phone. This app allows for quick access to call or text a parent in an emergency, and even holds insurance card information to be used at the hospital.



Unfortunately, this app has already been put to the test, when a student-athlete was taken from a competition via ambulance this Fall. Parents were contacted quickly, and insurance was processed at the hospital before the parents arrived to the Emergency Room. Luckily, the student-athlete has made a full recovery, but we are grateful to have been able to get the process started so quickly using the new app.
