Dear DePaul Catholic Community:

This has certainly been an interesting couple of weeks and, it seems, no matter how careful we were, this virus has become part of all of our lives. The entire school community has worked so hard and diligently to stay safe, but we fell victim to this invisible threat. However, like true Spartans, we have come together and continued our mission of delivering rigorous education.

The school will reopen on Tuesday, November 10th for in-class instruction ...it will be the second day of Marking Period Two! Over the days that we had been on remote instruction, the entire school has been cleaned and sanitized. We have used the ultraviolet light device in every classroom, the gym, cafeteria, Information Commons, and all offices. Everything that has been done has been directed towards one end goal - reopening the school for the safety of the students and staff.

I remind everyone that enters the building, a face covering that covers the nose and mouth must be worn at all times while on campus (except when seated and eating lunch), they maintain social distancing while moving around the building, there will continue to be temperature checks at least twice a day. Everyone is asked to wash his/her hands and use hand sanitizer. If we stay vigilant, we will be on the right path to staying healthy. We are in the process of rescheduling some events that had to be postponed due to the period of remote instruction, so please continue to monitor emails and social media for a revised schedule of events.
